Artists hoping to take part in the X Genalguacil Arts Festival must submit a proposal including the following information:

Fully completed registration form.

Resume of the artist.

Description of the project: in writing, drawing, scale model, or other technique which the artist may choose, in order that the jury can best understand the proposal.

List of items needed to create the art works: materials, tools, supports, elements for assembly and fitting, etc.

Detailed budget indicating the total amount to be supplied by the organiser.

Catalogues of recent exhibitions and any other information the artist considers relevant to help the jury assess the proposal.

## Genalguacil Town Hall

Genalguacil Town Hall is pleased to announce the X Genalguacil Arts Festival. In keeping with the spirit of past arts festivals, this year the search continues for creative projects that bring together art and nature. The delightful mountain village of Genalguacil, and its residents, will for a brief time become the protagonists in a unique experience of creativity, coexistence and nature.

### Rules of Participation

1. Artists will create their artwork in Genalguacil during the Arts Festival itself. Their work must capture the essence of the Genal Valley, either by using local materials and resources or by drawing thematic inspiration from the area.
2. The artwork produced during the festival should be in keeping with artists' previous projects, as seen in the portfolio submitted to the organisers during the selection process.
3. Artists will produce their artwork either in the open air, or in designated areas.



4. The Genalguacil Town Hall, organiser of the Arts Festival, will supply artists with materials and tools, as agreed beforehand upon acceptance of the proposal.
5. Artists will give all the works created during the Arts Festival image rights, and permission to reproduce said works to Genalguacil Town Hall. Their works thereby become part of the cultural heritage of the village to be exhibited in the streets of the village or its museum.
6. Artists will receive full board and accommodation as arranged by the Town Hall during the Arts Festival.
7. A broadcast will be made of the festival and the works created and an official catalogue of exhibitors' will also be printed.
8. A wide range of cultural and artistic activities will take place during the Arts Festival to foster an atmosphere of cooperation and participation between local residents and the artists.

Participation in the X Genalguacil Arts Festival implies full acceptance of these rules.
